Have you practiced your emergency response skills relative to these conditions? Do you have the tools available to simulate these conditions for your students and colleagues? Want to refresh your own knowledge of these EAP procedures? Come to the Skills Lab Primer and sign up for a time to practice in these 4 stations. Lab instructors will be available to assist with each station and lead participants through glucometer testing, insulin and glucagon injection; metered dose inhaler, spacers, nebulizers, peak flow meter use and asthma zone calculations; epinephrine auto injectors and oxygen administration; and naloxone administration and airway management for opioid overdose.

Lab assistants will be available to guide participants in self-directed skills practice, multi-media resources will be available for review and instruction, and cost estimates and vendor supplies lists will be available for participants to support purchasing decisions for AT clinical settings.

Skills stations available for practice, refinement and continuing education include:

- Diabetes Action Plan – glucometer testing, insulin and glucagon injection;
- Asthma Action Plan - metered dose inhaler, spacers, nebulizers, peak flow meter use and asthma zone calculations;
- Anaphylaxis Action Plan - epinephrine auto injectors and oxygen administration;

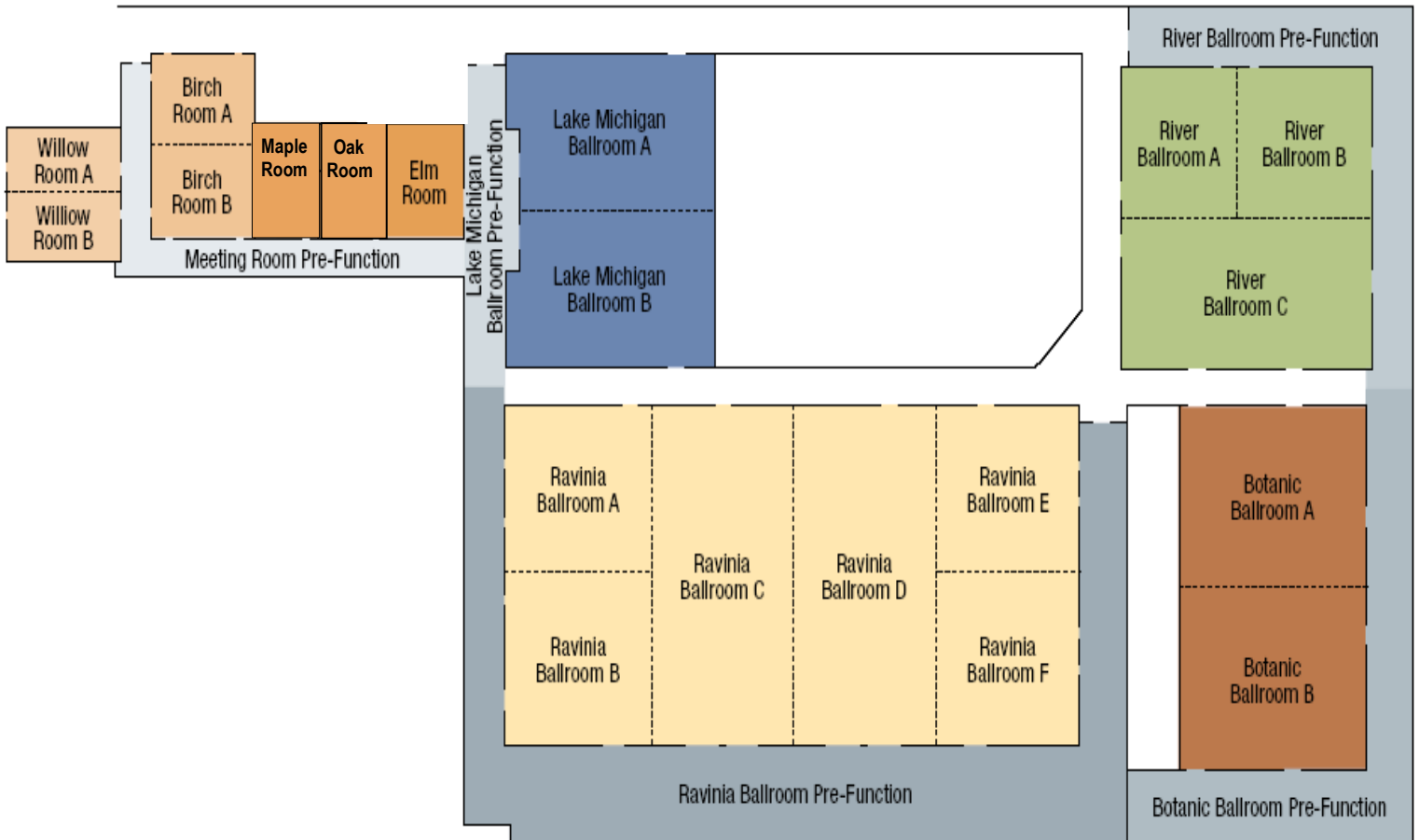
